Deposit

A deposit equal to 50% of the total package price is required upon registration confirmation.

The remaining balance must be paid 45 days prior to the event commencement date.

Overseas Travel Information

Transportation Guidelines

- Liquids and gels are prohibited in carry-on baggage during security screening, including beverages, shampoo, shower gel, sunscreen, facial cream, toothpaste, hair gel, and similar items.
- Lighters and nail clippers are not permitted through security checkpoints.
- Both lighters and matches are prohibited in checked baggage and carry-on baggage.
- When traveling between Macau and Hengqin, always carry original identification and travel documents.
- Personal household-use items are generally permitted; however, excess cash and dutiable goods must be truthfully declared.

Entry Requirements for Macau

Prepare the following documents:

- Passport valid for at least six months; or
- Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau with valid endorsement; and
- Applicable group travel endorsement for the Guangdong-Macao tourism scheme
- Return flight or ferry itinerary

Customs Reminder

Travelers are limited to:

- 19 cigarettes
- 1 litre of alcoholic beverages

The following items are prohibited from entry:

- Fresh fruits
- Vegetables
- Meat products
- Cultured pearls

Hotel Information

- Tap water in Macau and Hengqin is not recommended for direct consumption.
- Bottled water or boiled water is advisable.
- Minibar items and bottled water may be chargeable unless stated otherwise.
- Do not leave cash unattended in rooms.
- Use hotel safety deposit boxes for valuables.
- Hotel room doors often lock automatically; always carry your key card when leaving the room.
- Macau uses British-style Type G power outlets, while Hengqin uses Mainland China Type A/C/I outlets. A universal travel adapter is recommended.

Practical Information

Mobile Communication

- Activate international roaming and Hong Kong/ Macau roaming services before departure.
- Purchasing a Macau data package in advance is recommended.
- Mainland China mobile plans can generally be used in Hengqin.

Dialing Information

From overseas to Mainland China:

- Landline: +86 + Area Code (excluding leading zero) + Number
- Mobile: +86 + Mobile Number

Calling Macau:

- +853 + Telephone Number

Currency

- Macau: Macau Pataca (MOP)
- Hengqin: Chinese Yuan (CNY)

Macau commonly accepts:

- Macau Pataca (MOP)
- Hong Kong Dollar (HKD)

Although RMB may be accepted in some locations, exchange rates are often unfavorable.

Hengqin widely accepts:

- WeChat Pay
- Alipay
- Chinese Yuan cash

For major purchases, Visa and Mastercard are recommended. Please confirm that your card is enabled for international transactions before departure.

Tipping Guidelines

Tipping is generally not mandatory in Macau and Hengqin.

Many upscale establishments already include a service charge (typically 10%–15%).

Recommended Tips

- Restaurants: Approximately 10% if service charge is not included
- Hotel Porters: MOP 10–20 per service
- Golf Caddies and Course Attendants: MOP/CNY 50–100 at your discretion

Safety Information

- Store passports in hotel safes whenever possible.
- If carrying your passport, keep it in a secure inner pocket or travel pouch.
- Smoking regulations in both Macau and Hengqin are strictly enforced.
- Smoking is prohibited in non-smoking areas, including restaurants, hotel rooms, golf clubhouses, and many public spaces.
- Violations may result in substantial fines.
- Spitting in public areas is prohibited.
